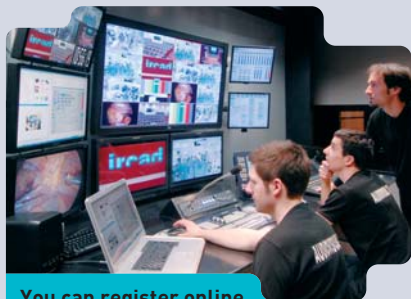

- Peri operative:
 - Gastric perforations
 - Bleeding
 - ...
- Specific short and long term complications
 - Banding: Pouch dilatation, gastric erosion
 - Sleeve: Leaks, pouch stenosis
 - Bypass and BPD: Gastro-gastric fistula, gastro jejunal perforated ulcer, internal herniations
